Dear Mr Quinn,

As we are currently well through the transition process to move the onshore support of the Schiehallion CPSS from Horsham to Aberdeen, I felt that the time was right to recognise the excellent level of support that the Schiehallion Operations team both onshore and offshore have received from Silvertech Ltd.

We have seen a continual marked improvement in the operation of the system as we have moved from the first oil date in 1998 to our current fourth year of production. The system now provides us with a stable platform to maintain our growing production rate from.
